- 1. The date for the next reading is planned for Friday October 18 at Dreigroschen theater. Jadi has contacted Helen Pavel and it has been approved.
- 2. Possible themes discussed?

- 3. The group decided not to have a joint meeting with the Society of Childrens Book Writers and Illustrators.
- 4. We voted to move the Dark Monday reading month from January to April and Charles Urban has approved.
- 5. Comments on what we do right?
 - a. We take pride in being a solid core group
 - b. The comments included that we are proud that we always pull it together for the readings.
 - c. Jim will add a link to the public page that highlights recent awards and publishings for individual members.
- 6. We voted YES to do a page on the website listing members' achievements.
- 7. We discussed doing an anthology of 2023 writings.
- 8. We voted to try to do readings in October and April each year.

- 9. We voted to move the annual meeting to January instead of February.
- 10. We do not know how much we made at the Dark Monday reading. Jadi will check with Charles Urban.
- 11. We voted YES to resume Write-Ins and to also use them for member conversations.
- 12. We voted NO to actively pursue members to either join or to attend meetings when they are delinquent. People who want to show up, do!
- 13. Members voted to resume ZOOM Write-in meetings between regular meetings. These meetings will be used for both write-ins and general conversation between members with no agenda.

The first ZOOM Write-in/conversation meeting will be Feb 24 at 10:00. Jim will update the Website to reflect Write-in/conversation meeting dates. Any member can host these meetings by starting a meeting from the WiS website.

- 14. Jim reviewed our website. The website should provide three functions.
 - a. Provide a place for the general public to get information on Writers in Stuttgart.
 - b. Provide a place for WiS members a place share information between meetings that is seen by the whole group.
 - c. Provide a mailing list of reading attendees and the general public to keep them informed about future readings and WiS information
